Noun: A **noun** is a word used to name a person, animal, place or thing.

Types of noun: Common Noun, Proper Noun.

Common and Proper Nouns

Remember, a common noun names any person, place, or thing. A proper noun names a specific person, place, or thing.

A proper noun always begins with a capital letter.

Example: boy, state (common nouns)

Rakesh, Kolkata (proper nouns)
