A **Singular noun** names one person, place, or thing. A **plural noun** names more than one person, place, or thing. Usually, to form the plural you just add *s*. Words that end in *s*, *sh*, *ch*, or *x* need *es* to form the plural.

<i>Examples :</i>	Singular Nouns	Plural Nouns
	car	cars
	bus	buses
	lunch	lunches
	fox	foxes
